**Name:**

Weinsberg Cuvée

**Location:**

Wine region of Mittelburgenland, Burgenland, Austria

**Soil:**

Loamy topsoil, rich in clay

**Harvest Date:**

October

**Wine Maker:**

Franz Weninger

**Varietal:**

Blaufränkisch 60%, Zweigelt 25%, Merlot 10%, Cabernet Sauvignon 5%

**Vinification:**

Only the carefully selected selected best grapes are used.

The wine is allowed to mature for a minimum of 16 months in French oak barrels

**Characteristics :**

Intense purple-red color, exceptionally elegant nose, harmonious and full bodied on the palate

**Analysis:**

Alcohol: 13,5 % volt,

Acidity: 5,6 g/l,

Residual sugar: 1,3 g/l

**Ageing ability:**

Ready to drink between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> year.

**Name:**

Weinsberg is a Part of the Trauttmansdorff surname, and reflects the wine tradition of this Family. Weinsberg translates as “wine mountain”



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
